There will be dinner with a luau theme, and a DJ. Net profit should be about \$15,000. Lynn has details and will send to the committee. A discussion ensued as to whether we could sell 325 tickets. Each committee member will sell 10 tickets. Charlie suggested Event Insurance. Chief Briggs will donate time. Lynn asked Cathy to see selectmen for event permits and ask Tammy if we can clear credit cards at town hall. We will need a port a potty for Wednesday and tents will need to arrive Tuesday. Electric - Eric to unlock electrical box. Lynn will check on insurance coverage for additional night. Charlie suggested a disclaimer if we don't sell enough tickets. Members thought it would be a great night out, dinner with community. Cathy made a motion to move forward with sweepstake raffle, Carol seconded. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
