

**Kingston, New Hampshire  
Board of Selectmen  
Meeting of August 11, 2014  
MINUTES**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm in the Selectmen's Office of the Kingston Town Hall. In attendance were Selectmen George Korn and Peter Broderick.

**Discussion with Michael DiCroce / County Attorney Candidate**

The Board met with Atty. Michael DiCroce, who will be a candidate in September for the Republican nomination for County Attorney. Mr. DiCroce outlined for the Board his 23 years of prosecutorial experience, including several years in the County Prosecutor's Office, and noted that if he's successful in getting elected he will walk into the office with more trial experience than any of the more than 20 attorneys now working there. He also summarized his plans to establish a mentoring program to train attorneys in trial procedure; to take a more aggressive approach to prosecution of crimes; and to set up units based on types of crime. If elected, he will divest himself of his interest in his current firm of DiCroce Prosecution.

The Board thanked Mr. DiCroce for coming in and wished him well in the Primary and General Elections.

**Opening of Bid for Sale of Cruiser**

Selectman Broderick opened the sole bid received for purchase of a 2006 Crown Victoria police cruiser offered for sale by sealed bid by the Police Department. That bid was from Chicago Motors in the amount of \$807.00. Police Chief Donald Briggs advised that he has received a local estimate of value for nearly twice that amount.

**MOTION:** Upon motion of Selectman Korn and second of Selectman Broderick, it was voted to table a decision on sale of the cruiser until Chairman Heitz can be present.

**Administrative Issues**

The Board approved use of the main meeting room for a Contra Dance on August 23<sup>rd</sup> but will hold off on approving additional dates until air quality tests for the Town Hall have been performed.

Two Notices of Violation were signed at the request of the Planning Board.

It was agreed that 2015 Budget Proposal reviews will begin at the August 25<sup>th</sup> meeting.
