



ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

Center entry is through a small 1-story gable-roofed porch supported by round tapered columns which rise to a boxed cornice with gable end returns. The multi-light door has two (recessed) panels below, sidelights extending halfway to floor level, and a louvered fan above. Windows are six-over-six with architrave trim. The low pitched roof is topped by two chimneys with corbeled caps, and the eave treatment consists of a boxed cornice with gable-end returns. The house rests upon a granite block foundation.
