



**ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:**

The Burbank House is a fine 2½-story, Georgian style structure. The center entry is sheltered by a 1-story, pedimented vestibule with pilasters flanking the (boarded-up) door. Windows are six-over-six with architrave trim. The low-pitched roof is topped by a massive chimney with a corbeled cap, and the eaves treatment consists of a boxed cornice with gable-end returns.

A 2-story ell has the same wall covering and eaves treatment as the main block, and a shed-roofed dormer on both the north and the south sides. Another ell has 1-story, with a gable-roof, boxed cornice, and the same wall covering. The south and north wings are each 1½-stories high, with clapboard siding. The house is attractively painted in beige.

**RELATED STRUCTURES AND CONTEXT:** There is a large separate three car garage on the east side.

**BOUNDARY AND ACREAGE DESCRIPTION:** 1.1 acres bounded to the N-Chase Street, S-Morse, E-Main Street, W-Clark.

The Judkins House is a fine example of vernacular Georgian architecture, the only one of this simple configuration in the district. Therefore, the Judkins House makes a significant contribution to the make up of the Kingston historic district.
