



ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

1½ story frame building.

Gable roof with simple overhangs.

Street face is center door with multipaned glass topped by small gable roof doorhood supported by truss brackets. Flanked by small square windows 2/1 with plain surrounds. Same experience on lateral side except major entry has double leaf doors with shed roof, doorhood supported by truss brackets and giving forth onto small deck.
