


ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

1½ story rectangular store with center entrance and large picture window on each side, each flanked by 4 light vertical windows.

Door is single large pane flanked by fluted pilasters supporting a partial entablature with scallop motif.

Entry sheltered by small unsupported door hood with motif in gable.

Wide clapboard with plain cornerboards and plain soffits.
