ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

The Sloan house is a 1½ story Georgian Cape. The center entry features a vertical board door. Windows are six over six and two over two with architrave trim. The eaves are treated with a boxed cornice on the lateral side and slightrned returns on the gable end. The medium pitched roof features a tall stove chimney with a corbeled cap. The house rests on a brick foundation. There is a 1 story flat roofed enclosed porch to the NE. A one story flat roofed wing is attached to the NE elevation, and a 1 story gable roofed enclosed porch to the rear (NW).

RELATED STRUCTURES AND CONTEXT: There is a 1 story separate gable roofed shed to the SW.

BOUNDARY AND ACREAGE DESCRIPTION: 4 Acres. Bounded to the N. by Federhen and Gould, W. by Pelletier, Sousa and Currier, S. by Little River Road, E. by Gould, and Little River Road.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Evaluation & Historical Associations):

The Elridge Judkins House is an early Georgian cape which has been heavily restored. Sited on a knoll on Little River Road, it makes a significant visual and historic contribution to the Little River District.

HISTORIC ASSOCIATIONS: House was in Judkins family in 1694. Barn moved across from Gould's house c.1964 (Site #9, H.D.2)
