



### ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

The Paglariuo house is a 1 1/2 story, Gable built in the Federal style. The center entry has a transomed door surmounted by a transom light. West of the window low sills over side rail, framed by woodwork trim. The medium pitched roof is topped by a massive central chimney and the roofline has a boxed cornice on the lateral eaves and close raking eaves. The house is supported by a stone and brick foundation above which is a wooden water table.

The 1 1/2 story, gable roofed ell has clapboard siding, six over nine windows and a recent door. It has a shed dormer on its west elevation and the structure rests on a cement foundation.

### RELATED STRUCTURES AND CONTEXT:

To the northwest of the main block is a separate 1 1/2 story, gable roofed shed.

**BOUNDARY AND ACREAGE DESCRIPTION:** 5 Acres. Bounded to the N. by land of Deyo, Abern & Clark, S by Ball Road and land of the DeButts, E. by Ball Road and land of the DeButts W. by land of the DeButts.
