




**ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:**

The Korn House is a 2½-story center-entry transitional Federal/Greek Revival style structure. The 4-panelled door has two-center pointed arches. It is flanked by paired, recessed sidelights that extend the height of the door. Pilasters with 2-center arched panels support a pediment. All windows are nine-over-six. The medium-pitched roof is topped by two chimneys, one of which has a corbeled cap. Eaves treatment consists of a boxed cornice with gable end returns supported by pilasters with recessed 2-center, pointed arches.

A 1-story gable-roofed ell rests on a concrete foundation. It has clapboard siding and nine-over-six windows.

An attached 1½-story gable-roofed garage rests on a concrete foundation.

**STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Evaluation & Historical Associations):**

The L. F. Prescott House is a well preserved example of the perpetuation of traditional house plan in the face of change, i.e., basic Federal house plan in transition in the Greek Revival period as evidenced in the Greek Revival doorway.
