


ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

The Palumbo House is a 1/2-story Georgian Cape style structure. The sidehall entry has a vertical-board door. Various window sash includes nine-over-six on the rear elevation, six-over-six, and two-over-two, all with architrave trim. Cornice treatment consists of close raking eaves and boxed lateral eaves. Three 1-bay, gable-roofed dormers each contain a window with two-over-two sash.

A 2-story, gable-roofed wing is in the Federal style. It has windows with two-over-two sash and architrave trim in the gable end, and clapboard siding. The low-pitched roof is topped by one chimney, and the treatment at the eaves consists of a boxed cornice with gable end returns.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Evaluation & Historical Associations):

The Pervere/Chase House is an interesting combination of two distinct residential styles, the earliest being a Georgian cape, to which was added a 2-story vernacular structure, giving it its present L-shape configuration.

Historic Associations: Possibly two houses joined together.
