MINUTES OF THE GENERAL ELECTION NOVEMBER 08, 2022

The Election was held at the Swasey Gymnasium, with the polls open from 8:00 AM – 8:00 PM. All Election Officials were sworn in by the Moderator. The sealed ballots were opened at 7:55 AM and distributed to the Ballot Clerks, absentee ballots were opened and processed at 10:30 AM by Moderator, Ellen Faulconer. 2943 ballots were cast on Election Day plus 254 absentee ballots, which is a total 3197. The election started with 4447 registered voters and 166 voters registered on election day. 72% of registered voters participated in the election.
