 - Date: Saturday of each recycling week (every other Saturday
- Or, Put glass products into your WASTE tote

That's right! Residents have TWO opportunities each month to help reduce recycling costs! By presorting these two items at the collection center, the town will save money (and ultimately our tax dollars!).

WHY?

That's because glass is not considered a financially viable recyclable on the world market. And although glass was once in high demand for processing into various industrial and consumer products, that demand has decreased dramatically in recent years. As a matter of fact, Kingston has to pay *per ton* to dispose of glass. Glass weighs a lot and it's become very expensive for our contractor to transport to their out-of-state customers making it unprofitable. And like most other contracted services, their cost of business is then pushed to us, the consumer.
