







KINGSTON RECYCLING & DISPOSAL GUIDE

Reviewed Nov. 2023

Recyclables should be loose, **NEVER IN BAGS**. Remember: “When in Doubt. Throw it Out.”
Bring glass & cardboard to the Collection Center at 27 Main St, other recyclables should be placed in your tote!

MATERIAL	INCLUDE	DO <u>NOT</u> INCLUDE	NOTES
GLASS COLLECTION CENTER OR TRASH 	Glass ONLY - including bottles, jars, ceramics, porcelain, pyrex, window panes, drinking glasses	NO Plexiglas, thermometers, lightbulbs, or automotive glass	Glass should be free of food, plastic, metal, or any other substance
CARDBOARD COLLECTION CENTER OR RECYCLING TOTE 	Corrugated cardboard (including clean pizza boxes with NO food)	NO waxed boxes that are stored in the freezer or refrigerator (such as ice cream pint or juice cartons) NO pizza boxes with <u>any</u> food residue	Please flatten all boxes Tape is ok Shiny finish is ok
MIXED PAPER RECYCLING TOTE 	Newspaper, mail, magazines, dry goods cartons, paper rolls, and paper egg cartons	NO shredded paper (discard in trash - it jams the recycling machines)	Staples, paper clips, and window envelopes are ok!
PLASTICS RECYCLING TOTE 	#1, #2, and #5 only! Look at the shape of the container - only include plastic bottles, jugs, and tubs. #5 yogurt cups are ok	NO #3 plastic (PVC or Vinyl) NO #4 plastic (single-use bags, plastic film, or bubble wrap) NO #6 plastic (styrofoam - in any form or packaging) NO #7 plastic (toys, furniture, or household items) NO plastic alcohol "nips" bottles	Check for ♻️ if no recycling symbol, then it's trash. <u>Empty</u> all food and rinse containers Plastic bags and film can be recycled at the Kingston Community Library or grocery store, NOT in the town recycling tote.
STEEL (TIN) CANS RECYCLING TOTE 	Empty soup, food, & coffee cans	NO paint cans	Please rinse, labels ok
ALUMINUM RECYCLING TOTE 	Beverage cans, clean pie plates and trays, foil balls more than 2"	NO aerosol cans or pet food cans	Please rinse, labels ok
TAKE TO <u>NEWTON OR RAYMOND TRANSFER STATION</u> (for a fee): <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scrap metal (not including steel or tin cans)• Carpets, rugs, or other floor coverings• Tires, wheels, and tubes - all sizes• Wood and wood furniture• Electronics (laptops, consoles, monitors, radios, TVs, speakers, electronic accessories, etc.)• Garden Hoses or Yard Fencing• Dishes and ceramic containers• Suitcases and purses (leather, cloth, or plastic)• Mattresses and box springs		TAKE TO <u>JOHN'S TRUCK & SALVAGE</u> (2 SARGENT ROAD, KINGSTON, NH): <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scrap metal (not including steel or tin cans)• Appliances (large and small)	
		TAKE <u>BACK TO THE STORE</u>: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Used clean motor oil - Kingston Public Works Dept. or Tractor Supply• Printer cartridges - Kingston Public Library or Staples• Light bulbs - Home Depot or Lowes• Rechargeable batteries - Lowes or Home Depot	
BRING TO THE <u>POLICE DEPARTMENT</u>: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sharps containers, needles, and expired medications• The police department will collect ammunition and firearms.• DO NOT transport explosive materials - please <u>contact the police department</u> for further information.			
BRING TO <u>HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DAY</u> (DO NOT TRASH OR RECYCLE): <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Empty fuel cans (plastic and metal) and empty propane bottles & tanks• Non-rechargeable batteries• Spray (aerosol) cans, oil-based paint cans, paint removers, and thinners• Hazardous chemical or cleaner bottles and cans			
IN THE <u>TRASH</u>: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Toys, Clothing, Towels, and Bedding (sheets, pillows, blankets) - consider donating to charity or put in trash.• Diapers, sanitary products, and pet waste are <u>NOT</u> recycled, please throw in trash.
