- Unitil Service Corp. - re: use of herbicides in the Unitil electric line ROW

- Email from Dana Akers, resident of Kingston, dated July 12, 2023 to the ZBA and Board of Selectmen (BOS). re: Unitil/utility line herbicides comments and information requests. Mr. Coffin read Mr. Aker's email.

Mr. Coffin mentioned that Susan Ayers, BOS Administrator contacted NHMA attorney regarding the BOS and ZBA's decision on their herbicide application. This information is privileged information.

- During the ZBA public hearing on June 8, 2023 the ZBA voted to deny Unitil's request for an Appeal to the Administrative Decision based on the fact that the BOS did not make an error in their opinion to deny the Unitil Herbicide proposal.
- The Board did discuss at the June 8th meeting the opportunity for Unitil to appeal through the special exception process. Shortly thereafter, it was discovered that a

- special exception only applies to certain categories and does not apply to Article 201.4:E-18 and they would need to apply for a variance if they submitted a new application.

 Unitil has decided to comply with the ordinance and will tell their contractor to use
 - Unitil has decided to comply with the ordinance and will tell their contractor to use less than 25 gallons of herbicide. They will not be applying for a variance through the ZBA.
 - Mr. Coffin read the letter from Chris Moultroup, Manager Forestry Operations of Unitil, dated July 7, 2023 that was sent to the BOS regarding the use of herbicides in the Unitil ROW's. (Copy available in the ZBA office upon request).
 - The BOS sent a follow up letter (signed 07/10/2023) to Unitil Forestry, Attention Chris Moultroup regarding the BOS initial letter of April 11, 2023 that denied their request to apply herbicide in the power lines right-of-way. The letter explained that the BOS "reversed their earlier decision based on the information gained during the ZBA process". (Copy of letter is available in the ZBA office upon request).
 - Mr. Coffin commented that the aquifer protection maps are on the Town's website under the Planning Board section. Any utility can get this information which will help them accurately map the aquifer protection zones.

Pam Brown of 23 Sunshine Drive was in the audience. She sent an email to the BOS and copied the ZBA. The correspondence was about the Unitil herbicide matter. Ms. Brown said that the email was intended for the BOS and not the ZBA, therefore, it was not discussed during the ZBA meeting tonight.
