Article 1009: DEPOSITING SNOW

(October 27, 2014)

1009.1 PURPOSE

The intent of this chapter is to prohibit the deposit of ice or snow from private property onto public property.

1009.2 AUTHORITY

Authority for adoption of the regulation is derived from New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated Chapters 41:11 relating to regulation of public highways, sidewalks and commons and 47:17 relating to adoption of Bylaws and Ordinances.

1009.3 It shall be unlawful to deposit or cause to be deposited any ice or snow upon a public way, sidewalk or public place in the Town of Kingston.

1009.4 VIOLATIONS AND PENALTY

Any property owner or privately hired snow removal operator who violates this regulation shall be fined an amount not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for the first offense and Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for subsequent offences.

1009.5 ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement of the regulation is delegated to the Kingston Police Department.

1009.6 SEVERABILITY

If any provision hereof, or the application of such provision to any person or company or circumstance, is held invalid, the remainder of the regulation shall not be affected thereby. (RSA 350-A:15)

1009.7 This regulation becomes effective upon adoption.
