One-time Highway Block Grant Payment

The Board has been made aware that a special one-time highway payment, in accordance with Senate Bill 401-Payment for Maintenance, Construction and Reconstruction of Class IV and V Highways - has been received. This payment is separate from the regular quarterly payments received through the Highway Block Grant. The amount received by the Town is \$144,859.78.
