

## **Article 1006: POLICE DETAIL**

(Adopted 11/23/2009)

### **1006.1 PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Regulation is to protect the safety of the general public, workers and contractors.

### **1006.2 AUTHORITY**

Under the authority of NH RSA 41:11 and RSA 47:17, uniformed Police Officers shall be present on site at all times whenever any road or roadside project is being done, unless otherwise determined by the Chief of Police.

### **1006.3 REQUIREMENTS**

- A. Any project that interferes with the normal flow of traffic or that presents a hazard to the traveling or pedestrian public must have a uniformed officer assigned to the project, with all costs to be borne by the contractor, homeowner or other appropriate party associated with the project.
- B. If, upon the discretion of the Chief of Police, a police vehicle is necessary to provide higher visibility in order to provide a sufficient level of safety for the project, workers, contractor and officer, the additional costs of equipment shall be borne by the appropriate party associated with the project.

### **1006.4 VIOLATIONS**

Violations of this Regulation shall be subject upon conviction to a fine of not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per day for each day of the violation.
