Southeast Land Trust Baseline Reports for Town Forests

Richard Russman of FOKUS and David Ingalls of the Conservation Commission introduced David Viale of the Southeast Land Trust. Mr. Viale presented the Board with five reports, for the five Town Forests on which the Land Trust holds conservation easements. The reports document the conditions of the properties at the present time, using photographs and observational reports. With the data available as a baseline, it will be possible to determine future violations as having occurred after the granting of the easements. The Board of Selectmen will need to review the documents and accept them. Annual inspections of each of the properties will be made by the Land Trust.
