

**Kingston, New Hampshire  
Board of Selectmen  
Meeting of November 24, 2014  
MINUTES**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm in the Selectmen's Office of the Kingston Town Hall. In attendance were Selectmen George Korn and Peter Broderick.

**Fire Department Warrant Article Proposals Discussed**

The Board briefly discussed with Fire Chief Bill Seaman and Deputy Chief Marty Conlon the proposed warrant articles to be considered at the 2015 Town Meeting, for purchase of a new fire engine to replace the 1993 engine now in service. It was agreed that any decision will be put off until a full Board is available. The discussion was postponed until December 1.

**Review of Previous Meeting Minutes**

**MOTION:** Upon motion of Selectman Korn and second of Selectman Broderick it was voted to accept the minutes of the November 17, 2014 meeting as printed.

**Administrative Matters**

The Board appointed David Smith of Depot Road to a position on the Conservation Commission, and appointed Krista Cambera to a position on the Kingston Days Committee.

An application for a Veterans tax credit was approved.

A Tax Collector's Deed for a Main Street property was approved.

Two letters advising property owners of violations were signed.

**Adoption of Snow Deposit Regulation**

**MOTION:** Upon motion of Selectman Korn and second of Selectman Broderick, it was voted to adopt the Snow Deposit Regulation for which a Public Hearing was held on November 17, 2014. The body of the Regulation reads, "It shall be unlawful to deposit or cause to be deposited any ice or snow upon a public way, sidewalk or public place in the Town of Kingston." The Regulation became effective upon adoption.

**Adjournment**

There being no further business before the Board, the meeting adjourned at 7:15 pm and the Board retired to review orders to pay and to attend to administrative matters. The next meeting will be held on December 1, 2014.
