Introduction of Candidate for Open Firefighter Position

Fire Chief Bill Seaman and Deputy Chief Rick Fowler were present with Firefighter Andrew Silver, who is the Department's recommendation to fill the open full-time firefighter position left by the resignation of Scott Noonan. Chief Seaman outline the process for hiring, including advertisement, oral boards and evaluation. He noted that Mr. Silver is fully credentialed and is at present working toward an advance EMT certification. He lives in Kingston and has been serving as a part-time employee for the department. He will start his new position at the appropriate wage level from the department matrix. The Board approved the hire and congratulated Mr. Silver.

Resident Discussion of Light Trespass Issue

Lawrence Faria of Drew Lane was present to discuss with the Board a light trespass issue emanating from a property located across the lake from his property. Mr. Faria present evidence, including photographs, demonstrating violation of the town's outdoor lighting ordinance. It was agreed that Selectman Broderick will speak with the owner of the property as a first step toward resolving the issue.

Administrative Issues

The Board signed an Intent to Cut for Merrill Avenue.

The CIP submittal for the Board for 2017 was signed and will be returned to the Planning Board.
