

**Kingston, New Hampshire
Board of Selectmen
Meeting of November 4, 2013
MINUTES**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm in the Selectmen's Office of the Kingston Town Hall. In attendance were Chairman Mark Heitz and Selectmen Peter Broderick and George Korn.

Discussion of Application to use the Plains for a HS Sports Program

Hayley Lane-Therault and her son Brandon were present to discuss the Board's prior denial of an application to use the Plains for a spring Lacrosse program. The Board explained that the Plains is not a sports field and that, while some very young players have in the past been allowed to hold practices, the Plains is the center of the downtown area and isn't available for use for high school sports. They suggested that a field area at the state park may be available, and asked if the school might consider letting the team use the Bakie School field for practices. Ms. Lane-Therault will look into those options.

Non-public Session

MOTION: Upon motion of Selectman Broderick and second of Selectman Korn, Chairman Heitz polled the Board for a unanimous vote to adjourn to non-public session under the provisions of NH RSA 91-A:3, II-a. The Board adjourned to non-public session at 7:40 pm. The Board returned to public session at 7:55 pm.

MOTION: Upon motion of Selectman Korn and second of Selectman Broderick, Chairman Heitz polled the Board for a unanimous vote to seal the minutes of the non-public session for an indefinite period.

Review of Previous Meeting Minutes

MOTION: Upon motion of Selectman Korn and second of Selectman Broderick, it was unanimously voted to accept the minutes of the October 28, 2013 meeting as printed.

There being no further business before the Board, the meeting adjourned at 8:15 pm and the Board retired to address administrative issues.
