Administrative Issues

Selectmen signed Intent to Cut forms for properties on Main Street, Mill Road, and Towle Road.

Richard Gerrish was re-appointed to serve on the Family Mediation and Juvenile Services Board in Plaistow.

A request for a brief extension in the deadline for payment of 2012 property taxes was granted. Deeding of properties with taxes remaining owed since 2012 is scheduled for this month.

The Board reviewed the 2014 state permit allowing the town's mosquito control program to proceed.

A letter from a resident concerned with school transportation policy was read. The resident will be advised that the Selectmen have no jurisdiction in the matter.

A request for enforcement from the Planning Board relative to unpermitted signs was reviewed. An initial Notice of Violation will be sent.

The 2012 audit management letter was reviewed and discussed.

A notice of a \$4,582.72 receipt from a drug forfeiture case was noted.
