

#### ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

The Norris house is a simple, 1%-story Greek Revival structure with gable front orientation to the street. The recessed sidehall entry has a new door with cornerboards and a partial entablature. Most windows are two-over-two and some are fixed. The medium pitched roof is topped by two chimneys and the eaves treatment consists of a boxed cornice with gable-end returns.

A 1%-story, gable-roofed ell has the same siding and cornice treatment as the main block. A small 1-story shed is attached to the rear of this ell.
