The Carruthers house is a 12 story, gable-moore , vernecular standards. The side 11

the observe stand. The media - litelatives is torped by a server corbel caped chirmey, and the roofline has a based cornice with a plain frieze and a sloped soffit along the lateral eaves. A fieldstone foundation supports the structure. The one story, gable-roofed ell has clapboard siding, one over one windows, and a fieldstone foundation.

The entrance is sheltered by a one story, shed roofed enclosed porch. To the lear of this ell is a one story, shed roofed ell with wood shingle siding, recent one-over-one windows and a cement foundation. A second 1-story, gable roofed ell extends to the northeast and has clapboard siding, two-over-two windows, and a cement foundation.

RELATED STRUCTURES AND CONTEXT: The north of the main block is a separate 1-story, gable-roofed ched. To the southeast of the main block is a separate 1-story, gable roofed garage.
