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ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:		
The Frice house is a l_{\perp} story cape built in the greek revival style which has been slight altered by some never additions. The center entry has a 6 panelled door flanked by full		
height sidelights. All of the windows have two over two sash except for a new picture		
window which has been added to the front facade (date unknown). The roofline has a boxed cornice with a wide frieze and gable end returns. Nide pilasters frame the main		
block. The house rests on a brick foundation.		
On the south elevation is a 1 story hip roofed wing with exposed rafters, clapboard siding, new two over two windows, and a fieldstone foundation. The he story gable roofed		
ell has clapboard siding, two over two windows, \sim nerrow corbel capped chimney and ϵ fieldstone and cement foundation. The entrance is sheltered by ϵ 1 story shed roofed,		
enclosed porch on the east elevation. The 1 story, shed roofed ell has clapboard		
siding, recent two pane windows, and a concrete block foundation.
