

## ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION: The Wills house is a 12 story, bungalou style atmosture. The center entry has a last clock door with one large light which has contiled light labou. It is sheltered by a 1 story 9 bay enclosed rorch which is incorporated into the main block. Above the entry is a 5 bay shed dormer. Both the porch and shed dormer have exposed rafters along the roofline. There are 2 bay, gable roofed dormers located on the west elevation. All of the windows on the main block have two over one sash. The steeply pitched roof is topped by a narrow chimney and the roofline has projecting eaves. The structure is supported by a fieldstone foundation, and cinder block under porch. To the west of the main block is a 1 story, shed roofed enclosed porch. Cinder block chimney on north side. RELATED STRUCTURES AND CONTEXT: A separate 1 story gable roofed garage is located to the southwest of the main block. It has an attached 1 story shed roofed shed on its north elevation. (Burned down c.1980) BOUNDARY AND ACREAGE DESCRIPTION: 3.0. Acres. Turneled to the G. By Shart Acres 12. by Rt. 12; h. by Kalman, w. by Belmer. REFERENCES: STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Evaluation & Historical Associations): The Wills House is a typical example of the Bungalow style popular in the first quarter of the 20th century.
