



ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

The lancaster house is a lastory cape built in the Greek Revival style which has further evolved with some victorian era additions including a lastory, hip-roofed, veranda along its front and south elevations. The center entry has a door containing ly lights. All of the windows have six over six sack fraced by chatters. The medium pitched roof is torred by a narrow, corbet capped chimney and the roofline has a boxed cornice with a plain frieze. The structure rests on a fieldstone foundation.

The lastory, gable roofed ell has clarboard siding, also over six windows with shutters,

The l_ story, gable roofed ell has clapboard siding, six over all windows with shuffers, and the same right doors it was block. It is to god by a narrow, corbed eagled chimney and rosts on a cepart foundation. All riory, and roofed shed projects to the east of the ell. To the northeast of the main block is a l story, shed roofed enclosed porch.

RELATED STRUCTURES AND CONTEXT:

A separate 1 story, gable roofed shed is located to the southeast of the main block.

BOUNDARY AND ACREAGE DESCRIPTION: 1.5 Acres. Bounded to the N. by land of the Spinellas, S. by Exeter & Hampton Electric Co., E. by land of the Senters, W. by Mill Road.

The M. Moody House is a simple vernacular example of Greek Revival cape style house plan. The well proportioned facade is hidden behind an ill-proportioned veranda added in the first part of the 20th century.
