

ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION: The Rosetti House is a 2½-story late nineteenth century wernacular structure. The sidewall entry door is sheltered by a 1-story shed-roofed porch with fixed nine lights, and two-over-one light windows. The medium-pitched gable-roofed of the main block is topped by one tall chimney and two shed-dormers. Cornice treatment consists of close, molded eaves, and windows are six-over-one with architrave trim. A large 2-story ell sits on a cement foundation. It has a gable roof with a plain boxed cornice, six-over-six windows with architrave trim, and one chimney. The other ell is similar, except it has six-over-one windows.

RELATED STRUCTURES AND CONTEXT: There is an attached 1½-story, gable-roofed garage. & 2-story shed* (on a cement foundation) is attached to the rear of the garage. (*chicken coop). Covered with asphalt shingles.

BOUNDARY AND ACREAGE DESCRIPTION: 12.0 acres bounded to the N-Rosetti, S-Gallant, Public Service Co. of NH., E-Mill Road, W-Public Service Co. of NH., George, Town of Kingston.
