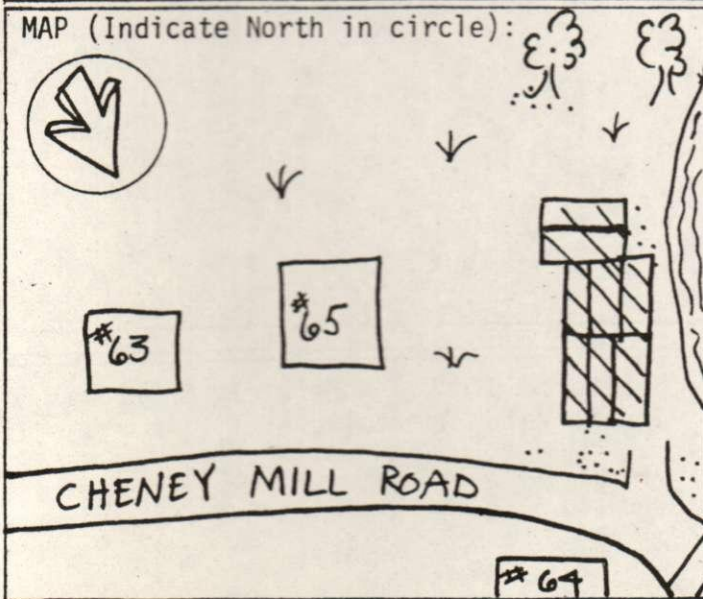

#### ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

This abandoned 2 story structure has a medium-pitched roof, close raking and lateral eaves, clapboard siding, and two over two windows.

A 2 story ell rests on a cement block foundation. It has two over two windows, and close raking and lateral eaves.

The other ell is 1 story and has a shed roof.

#### STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Evaluation & Historical Associations):

Contributing to the complex of structures surrounding the Cheney Mill is this small vernacular residential structure, which, for a period of time, housed the small store which served the area.

Built as a store for the little community around the mills, later used as a house and then as a storage shed for R. W. Cheney & Son.
