

ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

The Patterson House is a 1 story Cape built in the Federal Style. The center entry has a 4 panelled door with one light and is sheltered by a 1 story, gable roofed, enclosed porch. All of the windows have nine over six sash with molded trin. A 2-bay shed domes is located or the morthwart devation. The location about two pool is topically a march, corbel-caped of image and the coeffine has close rading and lateral eaven. A fieldstone foundation supports the structure.

A 1 story gable roofed wing projects to the east. It has clapboard siding, recent windows, and a concrete block foundation. The 1 story, shed roofed ell has clapboard siding, recent windows, and a fieldstone foundation. The 1 story gable roofed ell has

clapboard siding, nine over six windows and a fieldstone foundation.

RELATED STRUCTURES AND CONTEXT: A separate 1 story, gable roofed shed is located to the southeast of the main block.

BOUNDARY AND ACREAGE DESCRIPTION: 1.1 Acres. Bounded to the N. by land of the Nasons, S. & E. by land of the Cross family, W. by Cheney Mill Road.
