

ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:
The Jennings house is a $l_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ story, saltbox cape built in the greek revival style. The center entry has a 6 panelled door flanked by full height sidelights. All of the windows have either two over one or two over two sash. An exterior, concrete block chimney rises along the east wall and the roofline has a boxed cornice on the lateral eaves and close raking eaves. The structure rests upon a fieldstone foundation.
