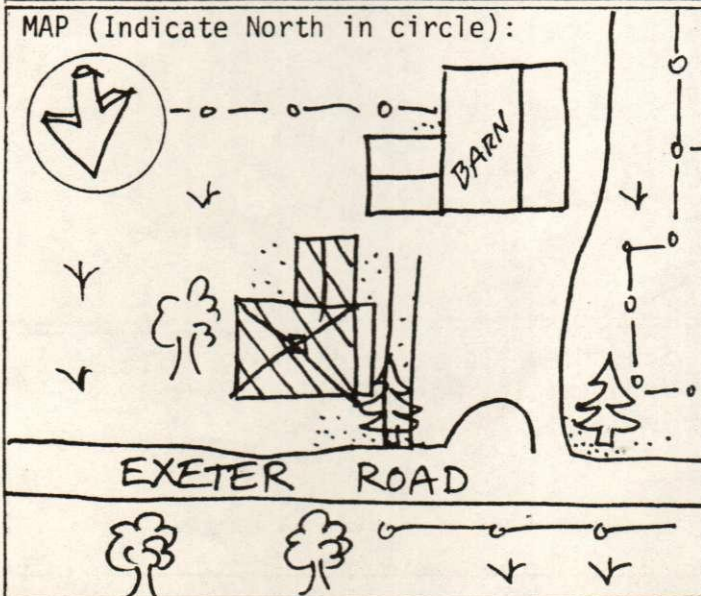

#### ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

This is a late nineteenth century house which was completely remodeled C. 1920, including the addition of a pyramidal hip-roof giving the structure a Bungaloid style appearance. The sidehall entry has a recent door sheltered by a 1 story hip roofed enclosed porch. All of the windows on the main block are recent. The house rests on a stone foundation which has been reinforced with cement.

A 1 story wing projects to the south of the main block.

RELATED STRUCTURES AND CONTEXT: A separate 2 story, gable roofed barn with four attached sheds is located to the southwest of the house.

BOUNDARY AND ACREAGE DESCRIPTION: 48 Acres. Bounded to the N. by Exeter Road, S. by Route 125, State of N.H., and Nason, E. by Warrington, W. by Route 125, State of N.H., Magnusson and Cummings.
