For renovation projects, the NH Department of Environmental Services and Kingston Health Officer must be notified at least ten days in advance of any asbestos abatement project involving greater than ten linear feet or 25 square feet of asbestos-containing building material (RSA 141-E).

Was the structure being demolished built prior to 1978? Yes NO If so, an EPA Certified Renovator must determine whether lead-based paint will be disturbed, and if so whether the project is less than 6 s.f. per room (interior) or 20 s.f. (exterior). If lead abatement is not required, a certificate to that effect will need to be made available to the town.
