

CARDBOARD IS A MONEYMAKING RECYCLABLE

- Take your cardboard to the town's Collection Center:
 - Location: Former state shed across from the Boat Launch, 27 Main St
 - o Time: 9am-Noon
 - Date: Saturday of each recycling week (every other Saturday
- OR, Recycle cardboard in your recycling tote

- Cardboard is recyclable as long as it is dry
- Pizza boxes are recyclable as long as they are not saturated in grease or food scraps.
- Remove any styrofoam or plastic packaging before recycling (This contaminates the cardboard)
- Break down boxes if possible

THE TOWN PREFERS YOU BRING CARDBOARD TO THE COLLECTION CENTER!

WHY?

Cardboard of all types is used world-wide to merchandise and package product. Cardboard is valued as a commodity like oil, gold, copper aluminum, etc; its value rises and falls with demand in the world markets. Our waste contractor takes and sells our cardboard to their customers, who in turn repurpose it into new products around the globe. Where the money comes in is how the town shares in the value of the collected cardboard with the contractor.

The more cardboard, the more money the town gets! By having a Collection Point, the town saves money by collecting in on our own to save contractor collection and sorting fees.
